Purpose of the proposal and its anticipated effects, including any changes in existing rules: The Paid Family and Medical Leave (PFML) program (Title 50A RCW) requires updating existing rules to ensure clarity and make necessary changes based on programmatic needs. Proposed amendments to WAC 192-620-035 provide clearer examples related to the proration of weekly claims for the benefit of employers, employees, and department staff. Proposed amendments to WAC 192-610-040 provide clarification by using plain language and allowing for department staff to consider all information provided when processing claims. Reasons supporting proposal: Proposed amendments to the proration rules are necessary to provide clarification and to ensure that proper payment is consistent with statutory requirements for instances where an employee's leave begins in the middle of the week. The proposal is also necessary to provide ease of readability and operational flexibility for department staff when determining whether benefit claims may be backdated.
